Dr. Robert G. Bea to Attend Butte County Board of Supervisors Meeting – June 27

“What is Needed to Make Oroville Dam Safe for the Next 50 Years”

OROVILLE – Dr. Robert G. Bea will be attending the Butte County Board of Supervisors meeting on Tuesday, June 27. The meeting will take place at 10:30 am at the Butte County Building located at 25 County Center Dr. #205, Oroville, CA. After the meeting, a semi-public lunch will take place at 12:30 pm at the Hof Brau located at 109 Table Mountain Blvd., Oroville, CA.

Dr. Bea will be presenting a 20-minute talk titled, “What is Needed to Make Oroville Dam Safe for the Next 50 Years”. He will also be discussing how he can work with the Oroville community regarding the Oroville Dam Gated Spillway. After the talk, he will be available for interviews at the Butte County Buildings until the lunch begins. The press is welcome to attend.
